Re: Summer uniform

As the country experiences a heatwave, the learners, especially the boys, have asked if they are allowed to wear shorts. This seems a very sensible request, therefore we are introducing an amendment to our uniform.

Between the beginning of May and the end of September, learners may wear <u>tailored, knee length, black school shorts</u> as shown in the photos below instead of black school trousers. These are available in store and online from many retailers including Sainsburys, Asda, Tesco, M&S and Amazon.

Please be aware cycling or sports shorts are <u>not</u> allowed and learners arriving in these will be sent home to change.



The shorts should be worn with their white polo shirts; white, black or grey socks and plain black full shoes or plain black trainers.

School sweatshirts can be worn as well if the weather is not too hot; as always, sweatshirts can be removed at school and left in lockers.
